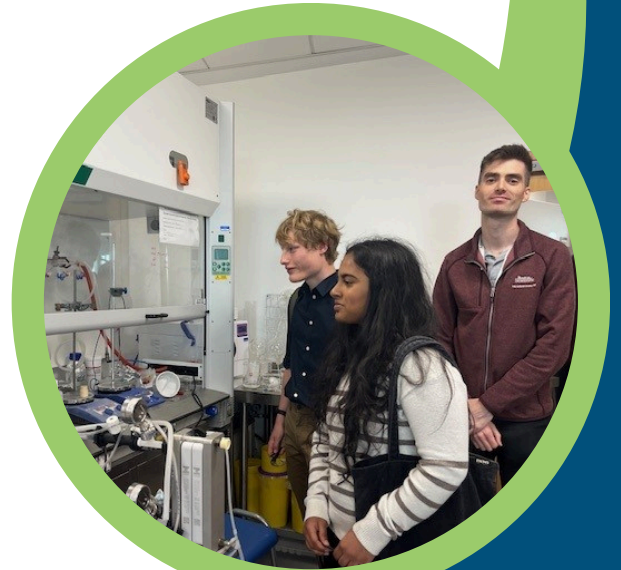
WHAT DOES IT INVOLVE?
